Details of Compulsory Testing Notice

(Persons who have completed a COVID-19 vaccination course¹ would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notices)

A. Specified premises under additional testing

- 1. Any person who had been present at Tai Po (North) Social Security Field Unit, 4/F, Tai Po Government Offices, 1 Ting Kok Road, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong for more than one hour at any time during the period from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on May 28, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by June 17, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between June 13 and June 15, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 2. Any person who had been present at Gyujin Shabu Shabu & Sukiyaki Restaurant (Tai Po Mega Mall), Shop 217, 2/F, Zone B, Tai Po Mega Mall, 8-10 On Pong Road, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong for more than one hour at any time during the period from 12:00 noon to 6:00 p.m. on May 28, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by June 17, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between June 13 and June 15, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 3. Any person who had been present at Shun Fuk Home for Aged, 1/F, Tai Po Commercial Centre, 152-172 Kwong Fuk Road, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong for more than one hour at any time during the period from 12:00 noon to 6:00 p.m. on May 28, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by June 17, 2021. If a person subject to compulsory testing has completed a COVID-19 vaccination course, he/she would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in this Notice. For both the Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine (CoronaVac vaccine) and Fosun Pharma/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (Comirnaty vaccine), completion of the vaccination course in general means having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before June 3, 2021. For persons previously infected with COVID-19, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course after receiving one dose of Comirnaty vaccine or one dose of CoronaVac vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before June 3, 2021. For persons who received COVID-19 vaccines in places outside of Hong Kong and have received the recommended dose(s) as stipulated in relevant guidelines at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received all of the recommended dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccine on or before June 3, 2021, they will also be regarded to have completed the vaccination course of the relevant COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on the list of vaccines recognised for this purpose as published on the Government's COVID-19 thematic (www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list of recognised covid19 vaccines.pdf).

subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between June 13 and June 15, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

B. Others

- 1. Any person who had been present at any of the below specified premises for more than two hours at any time during the period from June 2 to June 15, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff, students and visitors), has to undergo testing by June 17, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing choose to undergo testing using the specimen bottles distributed by the Centre for Health Protection, they have to return the specimen bottles with the sample by June 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between June 13 and June 15, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

 - (6) Kam Lam Catholic Kindergarten, G/F, Kam Lam House, Choi Wan Estate, Choi Hung, Kowloon, Hong Kong
- 2. Students of the schools at the levels specified below and teachers (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief teachers) of the specified schools who had face-to-face lessons with such students at the specified levels during the period from June 2 to June 15, 2021 have to undergo testing by June 17, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between June 13 and June 15, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
