

**Community testing centres
Persons eligible for free testing service
(as at 17 June 2021)**

Persons subject to compulsory testing

- Persons who had been present at specified premises or restricted areas during specified periods covered in compulsory testing notices
(details at www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/compulsorytestingnotice_premises_ENG.pdf)
- Staff members of residential care homes for the elderly (RCHEs), residential care homes for persons with disabilities (RCHDs) and nursing homes, day service units attached to the premises of residential care homes
- Household members of close contacts of confirmed cases (i.e. household members of persons placed under compulsory quarantine)
- Inbound persons (details at www.coronavirus.gov.hk/eng/high-risk-places.html and www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/concise_guide_vaccinated_travellers_ENG.pdf)

Targeted groups

- Staff of catering businesses and scheduled premises
- Construction site personnel (including registered construction workers and other resident site personnel) ^
- Staff of public and private swimming pools / beaches
- Staff of quarantine hotels and specified hotels
- Working staff accompanying and receiving local group tours (including tourist guides, tour escorts, staff seeing off the groups, drivers of chartered tour coaches and crew of chartered ferries etc.) ^

^ (i) Those persons who are unfit to receive COVID-19 vaccination because of health reasons are required to present a relevant medical certificate; and (ii) persons who have received the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine should present relevant vaccination record (such as by downloading their electronic vaccination records or saving the printouts of their vaccination records to their mobile phones, or bringing along the printouts or copies of their vaccination records).

Other eligible persons

- Persons with “LeaveHomeSafe” COVID-19 exposure notification, or SMS notification from the Centre for Health Protection of the Department of Health reminding them to undergo testing as soon as possible

Note: Any changes in the above information are subject to the latest on-site announcement at testing centres. If necessary, members of the public may also call the testing centres for enquiries on the latest arrangements before visiting.
