¹ If the relevant staff are unfit to receive COVID-19 vaccination because of health reasons, they must make a declaration by using the specified form available on the COVID-19 Thematic Website and produce a medical certificate to the licensee operating the tour or a person authorised by the licensee, and undergo a polymerase chain reaction-based nucleic acid test for COVID-19 using combined nasal and throat swabs within 7 days prior to receiving the relevant group tours and present the negative test result to the licensee.
