Details of Compulsory Testing Notice

(Persons who have completed a COVID-19 vaccination course¹ would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notices)

- 1. Any person who had been present at Christian & Missionary Alliance Shatin Nursery School, Unit No. 1-13, G/F, Oriole House, Sha Kok Estate, Sha Tin, New Territories, Hong Kong for more than two hours at any time during the period from June 11 to June 24, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff, students and visitors), has to undergo testing by June 26, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing choose to undergo testing using the specimen bottles distributed by the Centre for Health Protection, they have to return the specimen bottles with the sample by June 28, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between June 22 and June 24, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 2. Students of the schools at the levels specified below and teachers (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief teachers) of the specified schools who had face-to-face lessons with such students at the specified levels during the period from June 11 to June 24, 2021 have to undergo testing by June 26, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between June 22 and June 24, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
 - (1) Primary 4 of Carmel Leung Sing Tak School, Estate School No. 2, Shun On Estate, Kwun Tong, Kowloon, Hong Kong
 - (2) Primary 2 of Marymount Primary School, 336 Tai Hang Road, Happy Valley, Hong Kong

For both the Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine (CoronaVac vaccine) and Fosun Pharma/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (Comirnaty vaccine), completion of the vaccination course in general means having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before June 12, 2021. For persons previously infected with COVID-19, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course after receiving one dose of Comirnaty vaccine or one dose of CoronaVac vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before June 12, 2021. For persons who received COVID-19 vaccines in places outside of Hong Kong and have received the recommended dose(s) as stipulated in relevant guidelines at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received all of the recommended dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccine on or before June 12, 2021, they will also be regarded to have completed the vaccination course of the relevant COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on the list of vaccines recognised for this published the Government's COVID-19 thematic website (www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list of recognised covid19 vaccines.pdf).
