25 June 2021 Details of Compulsory Testing Notice

(Persons who have completed a COVID-19 vaccination course¹ would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notices)

A. Previous place of residence of a non-locally confirmed case

1. Any person who had been present at Tower 2, Springdale Villas, 80 Ma Tin Road, Yuen Long, New Territories, Hong Kong for more than two hours at any time during the period from May 31 to June 13, 2021 (including but not limited to residents, visitors and workers), has to undergo testing by June 27, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between June 23 and June 25, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

B. Others

- 1. Any person who had been present at Buddhist Chi Kwong Kindergarten, 3/F, Ancillary Facilities Block, Tin Yuet Estate, Tin Shui Wai, New Territories, Hong Kong for more than two hours at any time during the period from June 12 to June 25, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff, students and visitors), has to undergo testing by June 27, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing choose to undergo testing using the specimen bottles distributed by the Centre for Health Protection, they have to return the specimen bottles with the sample by June 29, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between June 23 and June 25, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 2. Students of The Church of Christ in China Chuen Yuen Second Primary School, 3 Sheung Kok Street, Tai Wo Hau, Tsuen Wan, New Territories, Hong Kong at Primary 2 and teachers (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and

For both the Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine (CoronaVac vaccine) and Fosun Pharma/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (Comirnaty vaccine), completion of the vaccination course in general means having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before June 13, 2021. For persons previously infected with COVID-19, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course after receiving one dose of Comirnaty vaccine or one dose of CoronaVac vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before June 13, 2021. For persons who received COVID-19 vaccines in places outside of Hong Kong and have received the recommended dose(s) as stipulated in relevant guidelines at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received all of the recommended dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccine on or before June 13, 2021, they will also be regarded to have completed the vaccination course of the relevant COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on the list of vaccines recognised for this published the Government's COVID-19 thematic website (www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list of recognised covid19 vaccines.pdf).
