

**Hongkong Post to issue “The 100th Anniversary of the Founding of the Communist Party of China” Commemorative Stamps**

**Issue Date: July 1, 2021**

This set of commemorative stamps is designed by Mr Tony HO, and printed in lithography by Beijing Stamp Printing House Company Limited.

Official First Day Covers have been put on sale at **\$2 each at all post offices** from **June 17, 2021**. Display of the commemorative stamps and associated philatelic products have also been put up from June 17, 2021 at General Post Office (GPO), Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office for public’s view.

**Sales Arrangements**

On July 1, 2021, all 38 philatelic offices will open from 9am to 2pm. Information about the sales arrangements is set out below:

### **Date-stamping Arrangements**

A hand-back date-stamping service with options of the office steel date-stamp, the special postmark, “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark will be provided on 1 July 2021 at all philatelic offices for official First Day Cover/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. The GPO-1 date-stamp impression will only be available at the GPO.

Besides, collection points will be set up at all philatelic offices on July 1, 2021 for submission of order forms of philatelic products as well as official First Day Cover/privately-made covers requesting hand-back date-stamping service.
