On 1 July 2020, Mr LUI was challenged and assaulted ferociously by violent rioters with umbrella and fists during the execution of duties. An assailant even used a sharp knife to stab Mr LUI. Despite the dangerous and life-threatening situation, Mr LUI strived his best and displayed an exceptional level of bravery and determination to perform his duties as a Police officer. During the incident, Mr LUI sustained serious and deep cuts.

Mr LAI Nestor Ngo-yau

Mr LAI, a Superintendent of Police, is awarded MBS in recognition of his act of tremendous courage, selflessness, commitment of duty, professionalism and gallantry of an extremely high order. On 20 July 2019, Mr LAI responded to a call to attend to one of the most dangerous cases involving homemade explosives in Hong Kong's history. At the scene, there were sensitive and unstable homemade explosives known as triacetone-triperoxide (TATP), which had been used in terrorist attacks around the world. Despite the dangerous and life-threatening situation, Mr LAI strived his best and displayed an exceptional level of bravery and determination to perform his duties as a Police officer. Eventually, the explosives were safely disposed of and destroyed so as to prevent attacks on Police officers and members of the public.

Mr Adam Alexander ROBERTS

Mr ROBERTS, a Superintendent of Police, is awarded MBS in recognition of his act of tremendous courage, selflessness, commitment of duty, professionalism and gallantry of an extremely high order. On 9 December 2019, Mr ROBERTS responded to a call to attend to the case involving two largest homemade bombs in Hong Kong's history. The two large bombs, weighed around 8 kilogrammes and 2 kilogrammes respectively and designed to be set off by mobile phones, were more powerful than that of the Boston Marathon Bombing in 2013. The explosion would cause maximum devastation and injuries. Despite the dangerous and life-threatening situation, Mr ROBERTS strived his best and displayed an exceptional level of bravery and determination to perform his duties as a Police officer. Eventually, the two bombs were safely defused so as to prevent attacks on Police officers and members of the public.
