## Hongkong Post to issue "Games of the XXXII Olympiad Tokyo 2020" Special Stamps Issue Date: July 23, 2021

This set of special stamps is designed by Ms Hikoko ITO, and printed in lithography plus hot foil stamping by Cartor Security Printing, France.

Official First Day Covers will be put on sale at **\$1.50 each at all post offices** from **July 9, 2021**. Display of the special stamps and associated philatelic products will be put up from July 9, 2021 at General Post Office (GPO), Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office for public's view. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from July 9 to 15, 2021.

## **Date-stamping Arrangements**

A hand-back date-stamping service with options of the office steel date-stamp or the special postmark will be provided on July 23, 2021 at all post offices for official First Day Cover/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide choices of "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark. The GPO-1 date-stamp impression will only be available at the GPO.

For the stamp issue to be launched while the pandemic prevails, Hongkong Post will implement a special sales arrangement to achieve social distancing and prevent crowds. The arrangements for this issue include:

1) Pre-ordering of philatelic products on the ShopThruPost website (shopthrupost.hongkongpost.hk) until 8 am on July 23, 2021;

 Collection points to be set up at all post offices on July 23, 2021 for submission of order forms of philatelic products as well as official First Day Cover/privately-made covers requesting hand-back date-stamping service.
