Details of Compulsory Testing Notice

A. Places visited by a preliminary positive case involving L452R mutant strain

1. Any person who had been present at The Wing, Cathay Pacific Lounge, near Gates 1 to 4, Level 7, Terminal 1, Hong Kong International Airport, Chek Lap Kok, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from July 25 to August 16, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
2. Any person who had taken any of Long Win Buses running on route number S65 from Tung Chung (Mun Tung Estate) to the Airport (Passenger Terminal Building) (Circular) at any time during the period from 12:00 noon to 5:00 p.m. on any day of July 25 to July 29, August 1, August 4 to August 6, August 9 to August 10 or August 13 to August 14, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and passengers), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
3. Any person who had taken any of Long Win Buses running on route number N64 from the Airport (Ground Transportation Centre) to Tung Chung (Yat Tung) at any time during the period from 0:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m. on any day of July 26 to July 30, August 2, August 5 to August 7, August 10 to August 11 or August 14 to August 15, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and passengers), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
4. Any person who had been present at Café de Coral, Shop 221, 2/F, Yat Tung Shopping Centre, 8 Yat Tung Street, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on August 15, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied

with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

5. Any person who had been present at GA GEE LOUNGE, Shop 114, 1/F, Yat Tung Shopping Centre, 8 Yat Tung Street, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 12:00 noon to 5:00 p.m. on August 11 or from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on August 14, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
6. Any person who had been present at PUTIEN, Shop 7E181, Level 7, Terminal 1, Hong Kong International Airport, Chek Lap Kok, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 4:00 p.m. on July 27 to 0:00 a.m. on July 28, from 4:00 p.m. on August 4 to 0:00 a.m. on August 5, from 4:00 p.m. on August 6 to 0:00 a.m. on August 7, from 4:00 p.m. on August 10 to 0:00 a.m. on August 11 or from 4:00 p.m. on August 14 to 0:00 a.m. on August 15, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
7. Any person who had been present at can.teen, Shop 7T090, Level 7, Terminal 1, Hong Kong International Airport, Chek Lap Kok, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 4:00 p.m. on July 26 to 0:00 a.m. on July 27, from 4:00 p.m. on July 28 to 0:00 a.m. on July 29, from 4:00 p.m. on August 5 to 0:00 a.m. on August 6 or from 4:00 p.m. on August 13 to 0:00 a.m. on August 14, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
8. Any person who had been present at Pizza Hut, Shop 24, G/F, Tung Chung Crescent, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on August 12, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
9. Any person who had been present at Windows Café, Shop 18-19, G/F, Yat Tung Shopping Centre, 8 Yat Tung Street, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New

Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on August 12, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

10. Any person who had been present at Gordon Ramsay Plane Food to Go, Shop 7E163, Level 7, Terminal 1, Hong Kong International Airport, Chek Lap Kok, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on August 9, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
11. Any person who had been present at 1/F, Block 2, Tung Chung Health Centre, 6 Fu Tung Street, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on July 30, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
12. Any person who had been present at Citygate (only the shopping mall is included), 18-20 Tat Tung Road & 41 Man Tung Road, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on August 12, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
13. Any person who had been present at Hang Seng Bank, MTR Tung Chung Station, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on August 12, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
14. Any person who had been present at Hong Kong Market (Yat Tung), G/F, Yat Tung Shopping Centre, 8 Yat Tung Street, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00

p.m. on August 15, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

15. Any person who had been present at Chong Hing Bank, Shop 1 & 2, G/F, Yat Tung Shopping Centre, 8 Yat Tung Street, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on August 14, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

B. Others

(Persons who have completed a COVID-19 vaccination course¹ would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notices)

1. Any person who had been present at any of the below specified premises for more than two hours at any time during the period from August 3 to August 16, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff, students and visitors), has to undergo testing by August 19, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing choose to undergo testing using the specimen bottles distributed by the Centre for Health Protection, they have to return the specimen bottles with the sample by August 21, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between August 14 and August 16, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

(1) Hong Chi Association Hong Chi Pinehill Pre-school Centre, Pinehill Village, Chung Nga Road, Nam Hang, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong

(2) The Salvation Army Lai Chi Kok Nursery School, 1/F, Prosperity Court, 168 Lai Chi Kok Road, Sham Shui Po, Kowloon, Hong Kong

¹ If a person subject to compulsory testing has completed a COVID-19 vaccination course, he/she would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in this Notice. For both the Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine (CoronaVac vaccine) and Fosun Pharma/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (Comirnaty vaccine), completion of the vaccination course in general means having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before August 5, 2021. For persons previously infected with COVID-19, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course after receiving one dose of Comirnaty vaccine or one dose of CoronaVac vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before August 5, 2021. For persons who received COVID-19 vaccines in places outside of Hong Kong and have received the recommended dose(s) as stipulated in relevant guidelines at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received all of the recommended dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccine on or before August 5, 2021, they will also be regarded to have completed the vaccination course of the relevant COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on the list of vaccines recognised for this purpose as published on the Government's COVID-19 thematic website (www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list_of_recognised_covid19_vaccines.pdf).
