Notes

- (1) The Hong Kong Museum of Art was temporarily closed from August 2015 for renovation and re-opened on 30 November 2019.
- (2) The permanent exhibition of the Hong Kong Museum of History was temporarily closed from October 2020 for renovation.
- (3) The Hong Kong Museum of Coastal Defence has been temporarily closed since September 2018 for renovation.
- (4) The Space Theatre and the exhibition halls of the Hong Kong Space Museum were temporarily closed from November 2015 for renovation and re-opened on 2 March 2016 and 25 April 2018 respectively. The Space Theatre of the Hong Kong Space Museum was temporarily closed from May 2020 for renovation and re-opened on 1 July 2021.
- (5) An increase in museum attendance figures in 2017 is attributed to the public's overwhelming responses to the blockbuster exhibitions organised to mark the 20th Anniversary of the Establishment of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.
- (6) Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the LCSD museums were temporarily and intermittently closed.
