

Hongkong Post to issue “Feel 100%” special stamps

(Issue Date: September 16, 2021)

This set of special stamps is designed by Mr Andrew LO with the comics created by Mr LAU Wan-kit. The mint stamps and \$10 stamp sheetlet are printed in lithography whilst the \$20 stamp sheetlet is printed in lithography plus sand varnish and spot varnish by Joh. Enschedé Stamps B.V., the Netherlands.

Official First Day Covers will be put on sale at **\$2 each at all post offices** from **September 2, 2021**. Display of the special stamps and associated philatelic products will be put up at General Post Office (GPO), Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office (TST), Tsuen Wan Post Office (TSW), Sha Tin Central Post Office (SCL) and Tuen Mun Central Post Office for public’s view from September 2, 2021; and the framed souvenir from September 13, 2021. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from September 2 to 8, 2021.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service with options of the office steel date-stamp or the special postmark will be provided on September 16, 2021 at all post offices for official First Day Cover/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address.

All philatelic offices will also provide choices of “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and its respective philatelic office pictorial postmark. The GPO-1 date-stamp impression will only be available at the GPO.

Special Arrangements

For the stamp issue to be launched while the pandemic prevails, Hongkong Post will implement a special sales arrangement to achieve social distancing and prevent crowds. The arrangements for this issue include:

- 1) Pre-ordering of stamp products on the ShopThruPost website (shopthrupost.hongkongpost.hk) until 8 am on September 16, 2021 or submission of the Advance Order Service Application Form by September 15, 2021;
- 2) Collection points to be set up at all post offices on September 16, 2021 for submission of official First Day Cover/privately-made covers requesting hand-back date-stamping service.
