Details of Compulsory Testing Notice

A. Places visited by the non-locally confirmed cases

1. Any person who had been present at Block 19, Baguio Villa, 550 Victoria Road, Pokfulam, Hong Kong for more than two hours at any time during the period from August 16 to September 9, 2021 (including but not limited to residents, visitors and workers), has to undergo testing by September 11, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between September 7 and September 9, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
2. Any person who had been present at Block 3, Kent Court, 137 Boundary Street, Kowloon, Hong Kong for more than two hours at any time during the period from August 13 to September 9, 2021 (including but not limited to residents, visitors and workers), has to undergo testing by September 11, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between September 7 and September 9, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

B. Others

(Persons who have completed a COVID-19 vaccination course¹ would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notices)

1. Any person who had been present at Sun Island Kindergarten (Tung Chung Branch), Shop K01, G/F, Coastal Skyline, 12 Tung Chung Waterfront Road, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, Hong Kong for more than two hours at any time during the period from August 27 to September 9, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff, students and visitors), has to

¹ If a person subject to compulsory testing has completed a COVID-19 vaccination course, he/she would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in this Notice. For both the Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine (CoronaVac vaccine) and Fosun Pharma/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (Comirnaty vaccine), completion of the vaccination course in general means having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before August 28, 2021. For persons previously infected with COVID-19, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course after receiving one dose of Comirnaty vaccine or one dose of CoronaVac vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before August 28, 2021. For persons who received COVID-19 vaccines in places outside of Hong Kong and have received the recommended dose(s) as stipulated in relevant guidelines at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received all of the recommended dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccine on or before August 28, 2021, they will also be regarded to have completed the vaccination course of the relevant COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on the list of vaccines recognised for this purpose as published on the Government's COVID-19 thematic website (www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list_of_recognised_covid19_vaccines.pdf).

undergo testing by September 11, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing choose to undergo testing using the specimen bottles distributed by the Centre for Health Protection, they have to return the specimen bottles with the sample by September 13, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between September 7 and September 9, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

2. Students of Bishop Walsh Primary School, 150 Junction Road, Kowloon Tong, Kowloon, Hong Kong at Primary 1 and teachers (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief teachers) of the specified schools who had face-to-face lessons with such students at the specified levels during the period from August 27 to September 9, 2021 have to undergo testing by September 11, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between September 7 and September 9, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
