22 October 2021 Details of Compulsory Testing Notice

A. Places visited by the non-locally confirmed case

1. Any person who had been present at Tower 9, Phase 3 - Carmel Cove, Caribbean Coast, 1 Kin Tung Road, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong for more than two hours at any time during the period from 30 September to 22 October 2021 (including but not limited to residents, visitors and workers), has to undergo testing by 24 October 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 October and 22 October 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

B. Others

(Persons who have completed a COVID-19 vaccination course¹ would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notices)

- 1. Any person who had been present at any of the below specified premises for more than two hours at any time during the period from 9 October to 22 October 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff, students and visitors), has to undergo testing by 24 October 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing choose to undergo testing using the specimen bottles distributed by the Centre for Health Protection, they have to return the specimen bottles with the sample by 26 October 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 October and 22 October 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
 - (1) Hong Chi Shiu Pong Morninghope School, 9 Chung Mun Road, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong

If a person subject to compulsory testing has completed a COVID-19 vaccination course, he/she would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in this Notice. For both the Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine (CoronaVac vaccine) and Fosun Pharma/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (Comirnaty vaccine), completion of the vaccination course in general means having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before 10 October 2021. For persons previously infected with COVID-19, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course after receiving one dose of Comirnaty vaccine or one dose of CoronaVac vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before 10 October 2021. For persons who received COVID-19 vaccines in places outside of Hong Kong and have received the recommended dose(s) as stipulated in relevant guidelines at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received all of the recommended dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccine on or before 10 October 2021, they will also be regarded to have completed the vaccination course of the relevant COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on the list of vaccines recognised for this purpose as published on the Government's COVID-19 thematic website (www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list of recognised covid19 vaccines.pdf).

- (2) Tsung Tsin Mission of Hong Kong On Yee Nursery School, G/F, Ko Shing House, Ko Yee Estate, Yau Tong, Kowloon, Hong Kong
- 2. Students of Chun Tok School, 171 Hammer Hill Road, Diamond Hill, Kowloon, Hong Kong at Primary 1 and teachers (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief teachers) who had face-to-face lesson(s) with such students at the Specified Levels during the period from 9 October to 22 October 2021 have to undergo testing by 24 October 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 October and 22 October 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
