- (i) When arriving at the CTCs at the designated time slot, eligible persons should present identity document used at the time of booking (such as Hong Kong identity card or passport) and the SMS booking confirmation.
- (ii) Starting from August 2, all government employees have been subject to the vaccination in lieu of regular testing (VRT) arrangement. With effect from September 1, save for those who are unfit to receive COVID-19 vaccination because of medical conditions supported by a medical

certificate, all government employees (covering civil servants and full-time or part-time government employees appointed on non-civil service terms) who have not received their first dose of a vaccine should take the regular polymerase chain reaction-based nucleic acid tests for COVID-19 (PCR tests) at CTCs outside working hours and pay for these tests at their own expense.

- (iii)The Hospital Authority has made reference to the arrangement for government employees and announced that with effect from September 1, all staff members, except for those vaccinated or those who can present medical certificates, will have to undergo biweekly PCR tests outside working hours and at staff members' own expenses. To further minimise the risks of high exposure groups, with effect from October 27, healthcare staff handling COVID-19 cases in the North Lantau Hospital Hong Kong Infection Control Centre (HKICC) have to undergo PCR tests every three days. The HKICC has already set up testing stations to implement the relevant arrangements.
- (iv)In general, completing a vaccination course involves having received two doses of CoronaVac or Comirnaty COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days ago. For staff members aged 17 or below and employed in compliance with the Employment Ordinance (Chapter 57) who have received one dose of Comirnaty vaccine at least 14 days ago are deemed to have completed a COVID-19 vaccination course.
