22 November 2021 Details of Compulsory Testing Notice

A. Places visited by the preliminary positive imported case who had stayed in Hong Kong during the incubation period

- 1. Any person who had been present at Winning House, 72-76 Wing Lok Street, Sheung Wan, Hong Kong for more than 2 hours at any time during the period from 31 October 2021 to 22 November 2021 (including but not limited to residents, visitors and workers), has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 2. Any person who had been present at Morgan Stanley Bank Asia Limited, Level 37, International Commerce Centre, 1 Austin Road West, Yau Tsim Mong, Kowloon, Hong Kong for more than 1 hour at any time during the period from 31 October to 3 November 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 3. Any person who had been present at La Vache!, G/F, 48 Peel Street, Soho, Central, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on 31 October 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 4. Any person who had been present at Honky Tonks Tavern, G/F, 75 Hollywood Road, Central, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on 31 October 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 5. Any person who had been present at ICHU, 3/F, H Queen's, 80 Queen's Road Central, Central, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on 31 October 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

- 6. Any person who had been present at Hong Kong Football Club, 3 Sports Road, Happy Valley, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on 4 November 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 7. Any person who had been present at AMTARDA, Tai Au Mun Village, Tai Wan Tau Road, Clear Water Bay, Sai Kung, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on 6 November 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

B. Specified premises under additional testing

- 1. Any person who had been present at Bauhinia Restaurant, 3/F, Pacific Club, Harbour City, Tsim Sha Tsui, Kowloon, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 6:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. on 5 November 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 2. Any person who had been present at 1/F, Pacific Club, Harbour City, Tsim Sha Tsui, Kowloon, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 12:00 noon to 4:00 p.m. on 4 November 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 3. Any person who had been present at K11 MUSEA, 18 Salisbury Road, Tsim Sha Tsui, Kowloon, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 3:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on 4 November 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
- 4. Any person who had been present at Lai Chi Kok Park Sports Centre, 1 Lai Wan Road, Lai Chi Kok, Kowloon, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on 11 November 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would

be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

C. Others

(Persons who have completed a COVID-19 vaccination course¹ would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notices)

- 1. Any person who had been present at any of the below specified premises for more than two hours at any time during the period from 9 November to 22 November 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff, students and visitors) has to undergo testing by 24 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing choose to undergo testing using the specimen bottles distributed by the Centre for Health Protection, they have to return the specimen bottles with the sample by 26 November 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 20 November and 22 November 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

If a person subject to compulsory testing has completed a COVID-19 vaccination course, he/she would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in this Notice. For both the Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine (CoronaVac vaccine) and Fosun Pharma/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (Comirnaty vaccine), completion of the vaccination course in general means having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before 10 November, 2021. For persons previously infected with COVID-19, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course after receiving one dose of Comirnaty vaccine or one dose of CoronaVac vaccine at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before 10 November, 2021. For persons who received COVID-19 vaccines in places outside of Hong Kong and have received the recommended dose(s) as stipulated in relevant guidelines at least 14 days ago, i.e. having received all of the recommended dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccine on or before 10 November, 2021, they will also be regarded to have completed the vaccination course of the relevant COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on the list of vaccines recognised for this published the Government's COVID-19 thematic (www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list of recognised covid19 vaccines.pdf).
