** : Information of the injury cases

- (a) **Age profile:** There were 53 persons injured, among which 41 were adults, eight, elderly, two, children and two, with ages unknown.
- (b) **Severity of the injuries:** 44 of the wounded required admission to hospitals clinics for medical treatment, among which 12 were hospitalised (six of them required surgery). Another three had minor injuries and condition of another six was unknown.
- (c) **The cause of wild pig injury :**
 - 19 cases were caused by biting by wild pigs snatching food or mistaking food being available;
 - eight cases were caused by barging wild pigs which were trapped in urban areas and frightened;
 - six cases were caused by barging wild pigs in self-defence or running away when being driven away by people or dogs;
 - one case was about a knock down caused by wild pigs chasing each other; and
 - eight cases were unknown.
