**Details of Compulsory Testing Notice**

**A. Places visited by the preliminary positive imported cases who had stayed in Hong Kong during the incubation period**

1. Any person who had been present at Block 1, Rambler Crest, 1 Tsing Yi Road, Tsing Yi, New Territories, Hong Kong for more than 2 hours at any time during the period from 27 November to 19 December 2021 (including but not limited to residents, visitors and workers), has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
2. Any person who had been present at can.teen, Unit 7T090, Level 7, Departures Hall, Terminal 1, Hong Kong International Airport, 1 Cheong Tat Road, Chek Lap Kok, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on 7 December 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
3. Any person who had been present at Food Court, 4/F, Langham Place Shopping Mall, 8 Argyle Street, Mong Kok, Kowloon, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 8:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on 2 December 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
4. Any person who had been present at Block 18A, Serenity Villa, 230A Tai Po Tau, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong for more than 2 hours at any time during the period from 28 November to 19 December 2021 (including but not limited to residents, visitors and workers), has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
5. Any person who had been present at The Wing, First, Level 7, Terminal 1 near gates 1 to 4, Hong Kong International Airport, 1 Cheong Tat Road, Chek Lap Kok, Lantau Island, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on 16 December 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors), has to undergo testing by

21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

6. Any person who had been present at The Ladies' Purse, 2/F, Sha Tin Clubhouse, The Hong Kong Jockey Club, 6001 Tai Po Road Sha Tin, Sha Tin, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on 15 December 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors) has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
7. Any person who had been present at Tai Po Hui Cooked Food Centre, 2/F, Tai Po Complex, 8 Heung Sze Wui Street, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 12:00 noon to 2:00 p.m. on 30 November 2021, from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on 3 December 2021, from 12:00 noon to 2:00 p.m. on 8 December 2021, from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on 13 December 2021, or from 12:00 noon to 1:00 p.m. on 15 December 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors) has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
8. Any person who had been present at Kwong Shing Noodle Shop, Shop A, G/F, Mei Wan Building, 46-52 Po Heung Street, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on 29 November 2021, from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. on 2 December 2021, from 12:00 noon to 1:00 p.m. on 4 December 2021, from 12:00 noon to 1:00 p.m. on 6 December 2021, from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on 11 December 2021, from 12:00 noon to 1:00 p.m. on 12 December 2021, from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. on 13 December 2021, or from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on 14 December 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors) has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
9. Any person who had been present at Oi Suen, 3/F, Sha Tin Clubhouse, The Hong Kong Jockey Club, 6001 Tai Po Road Sha Tin, Sha Tin, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on 2 December 2021, or from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on 13 December 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors) has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
10. Any person who had been present at Tai Po Hui Market, G/F - 2/F, Tai Po

Complex, 8 Heung Sze Wui Street, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on 29 November 2021, from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on 3 December 2021, or from 12:00 noon to 2:00 p.m. on 12 December 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors) has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

Any person who had been present at HK Medical, Room 2102-2107, 21/F, 700 Nathan Road, Mong Kok, Kowloon, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on 6 December 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors) has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
12. Any person who had been present at HANCHAM Premium Korean Food & Cafe, Shop UG43, UG/F, Empire Centre, 68 Mody Road, Tsim Sha Tsui, Kowloon, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on 3 December 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors) has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

Any person who had been present at Plover Cove Road Market, G/F, 3 Plover Cove Road, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong at any time during the period from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. on 30 November 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff and visitors) has to undergo testing by 21 December 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between 17 December and 19 December 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
