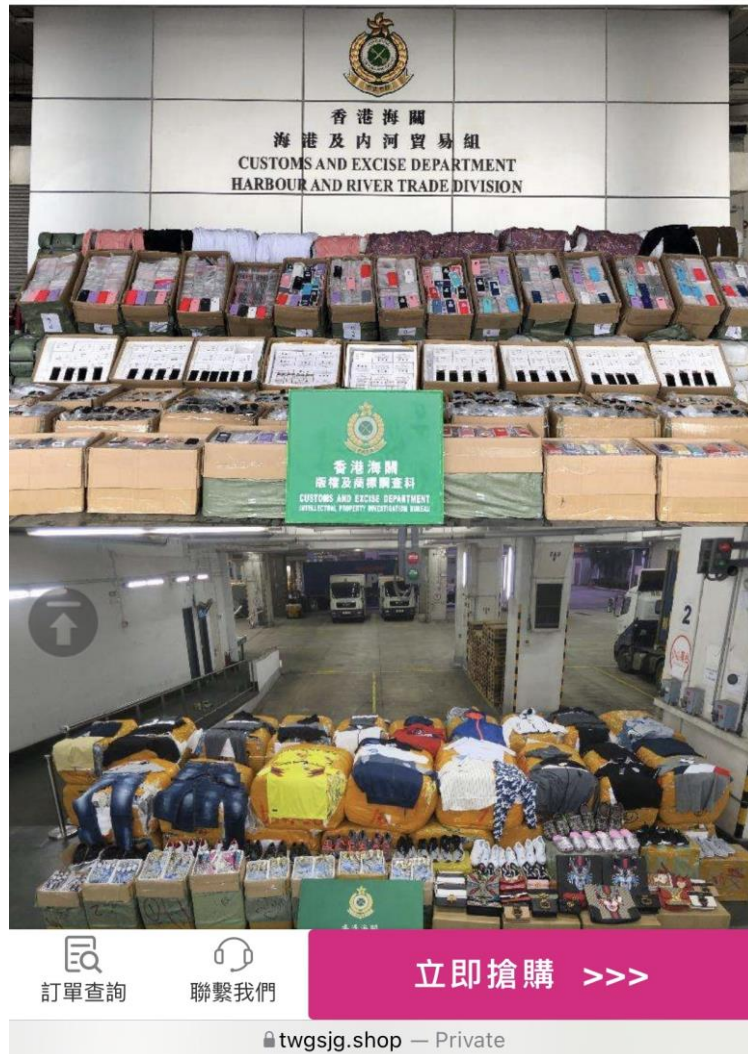


## 重大消息！
