## Conditions to the

## Permission\* for group and multi-household gatherings in relation to the Chief Executive Election

- (1) all guests must wear marks at all times;
- (2) no food and beverage should be provided;
- (3) the gatherings should strictly adhere to the applicable directions in Prevention and Control of Disease (Requirements and Directions) (Business and Premises) Regulation (Cap. 599F), Prevention and Control of Disease (Wearing of Mask) Regulation (Cap. 599I) and Prevention and Control of Disease (Vaccine Pass) Regulation (Cap. 599L), including the requirements applicable to Cap. 599F premises, mask-wearing requirement under Cap. 599I, vaccine pass requirement under Cap. 599L, etc.;
- (4) on top of the existing Cap. 599F, Cap. 599I and Cap. 599L requirements, organisers should follow the Department of Health's "Guidelines on Prevention of COVID-19 for Event Organiser of Mass Assembly" when planning the event (see: https://www.chp.gov.hk/files/pdf/novel\_infectious\_agent\_event\_organiser\_of\_mass\_assembly\_en.pdf);
- (5) body temperature screening should be arranged for participants and only participants with body temperature lower than 37 °C should be allowed to enter; and
- (6) the organiser should keep a list of all events, attendance record and contact information of all participants. The lists should be made available for Government Departments for the purpose of contact tracing as and when necessary.
- \* The permission applies to indoor group gatherings which take place in a public place governed under Cap. 599G and does not cover outdoor group gatherings. Indoor means:
  - (a) having a ceiling or roof, or a cover that functions (whether temporarily or permanently) as a ceiling or roof; and
  - (b) having at least 50% of the total area of all sides enclosed (whether temporarily or permanently) otherwise than by
    - (i) any window or door that can be opened; or
    - (ii) any opening that functions as such a window or door.
