This set of special stamps is designed by Mr. Arde LAM, and printed in lithography plus holographic hot foil by Cartor Security Printing, France.

Official First Day Covers for "China's Aerospace Development" are put on sale at \$2.5 each at all post offices from 4 April 2022. Display of the special stamps and associated philatelic products will be put up at General Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office on 11 April 2022 for public's view. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 4 to 9 April 2022.

All philatelic offices will also provide "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and its respective philatelic office pictorial postmark. The GPO-1 date-stamp impression will only be available at the GPO.

To observe social distancing and prevent crowd gathering, collection points will be set up at all post offices on 21 April 2022 for submission of Official First Day Covers/privately-made covers requesting hand-back date-stamping service.
