- Note 2: Commercial vehicles include goods vehicles, special purpose vehicles, trailers, taxis, non-franchised public buses, franchised public buses (vehicle examination fee only, as vehicle licence fee of franchised buses has already been waived under the Elderly Concessionary Fare Scheme since 1993), private buses, light buses (both public and private) and hire cars.
- Note 3: Eligible types of vehicles include non-franchised public buses, private buses for student service, and public light buses (including both red and green public light buses).
- Note 4: Eligible types of Hire Car Permits include hotel hire car service, tour hire car service, private hire car service, private hire car service, private hire car service (limousine) and private hire car service (limousine cross boundary).
- Note 5: Twelve groups of measures (including 13, 15, 18-23 and 31-34) can be implemented by the Government administratively. No additional subsidiary legislation will be required.
- Note 6: Places of public entertainment include family amusement centres and exhibition venues, etc.
- Note 7: It is assumed that almost all the revenue from licensing of travel agents will no longer be under the Government because the fees currently collected by the Travel Agents Registry will be collected by the Travel Industry Authority (TIA), a statutory body established under the Travel Industry Ordinance (Cap. 634), upon TIA's full commencement of operation tentatively within 2022. Should TIA commence full operation on or before 30 September 2023, TIA will maintain the fee waiver until 30 September 2023. The estimated annual revenue forgone for TIA will be \$10M.
