For eligible social security recipients, the amount of the one-off extra allowance is equal to half of one month of the standard rate of Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) payments, Old Age Allowance (OAA), Old Age Living Allowance (OALA) or Disability Allowance (DA). Examples of payment levels are as follows:

As regards the Working Family Allowance, the one-off extra allowance is equal to half of the average monthly amount of approved months payable to the corresponding households in their most recently submitted applications in the period from November 1, 2021 to May 4, 2022, and eventually approved. The amount varies from case to case.
