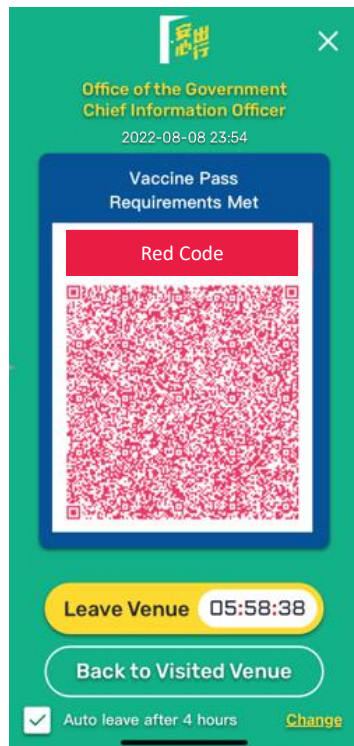

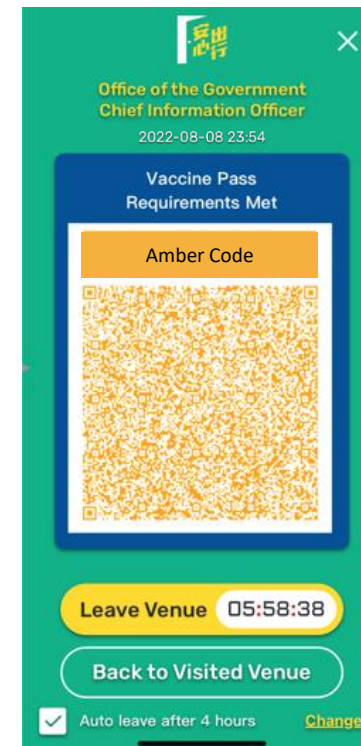
# Red/ Amber Codes under Vaccine Pass

## Differentiate and restrict high-risk persons

Red Code - Confirmed cases  
(under isolation)



Amber Code - Inbound persons  
(under quarantine)

## Data analysis

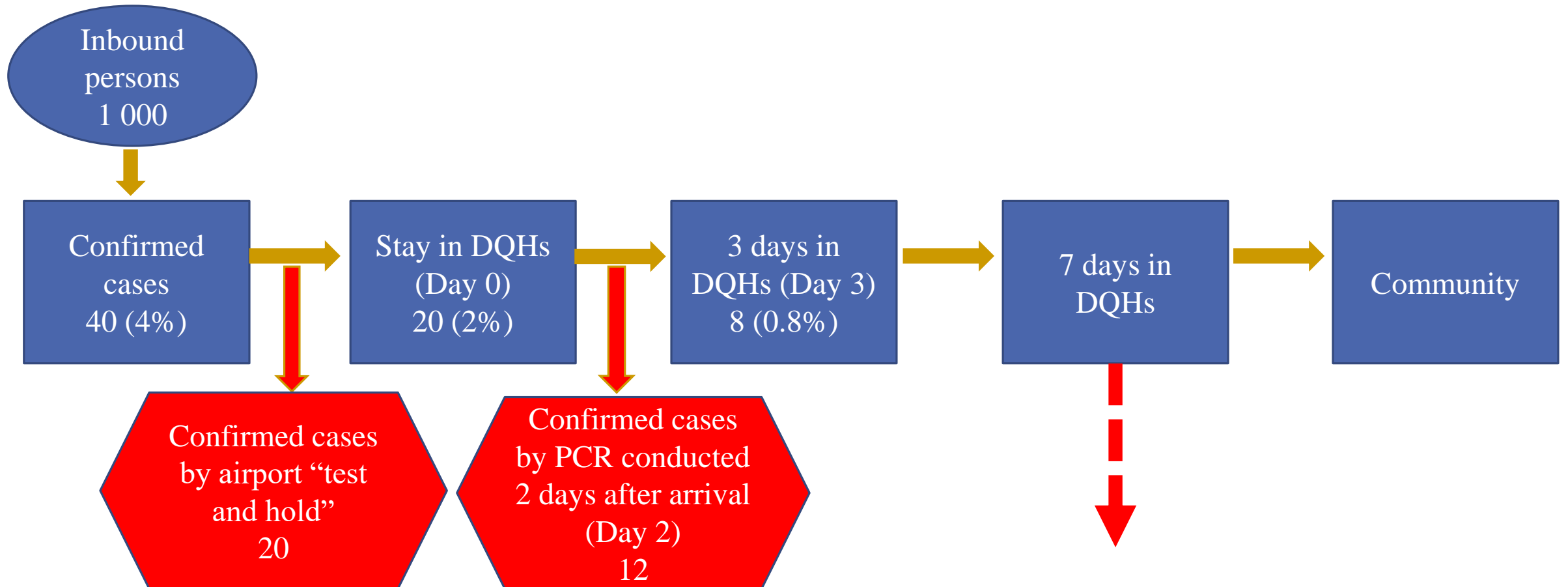
Dates	Confirmed cases (Cumulative proportion of confirmed cases detected)		Proportion of positive cases during the period
	PCR at the airport (Day 0)	*PCR after two days	
8/7 – 14/7	47%	75%	
15/7 – 21/7	47%	79%	
22/7 – 28/7	51%	78%	
29/7 – 4/8	47%	79%	
Total	About 50%	About 80%	About 4%

\*The PCR test conducted two days after arrival at Hong Kong was introduced on 8 July, 2022.

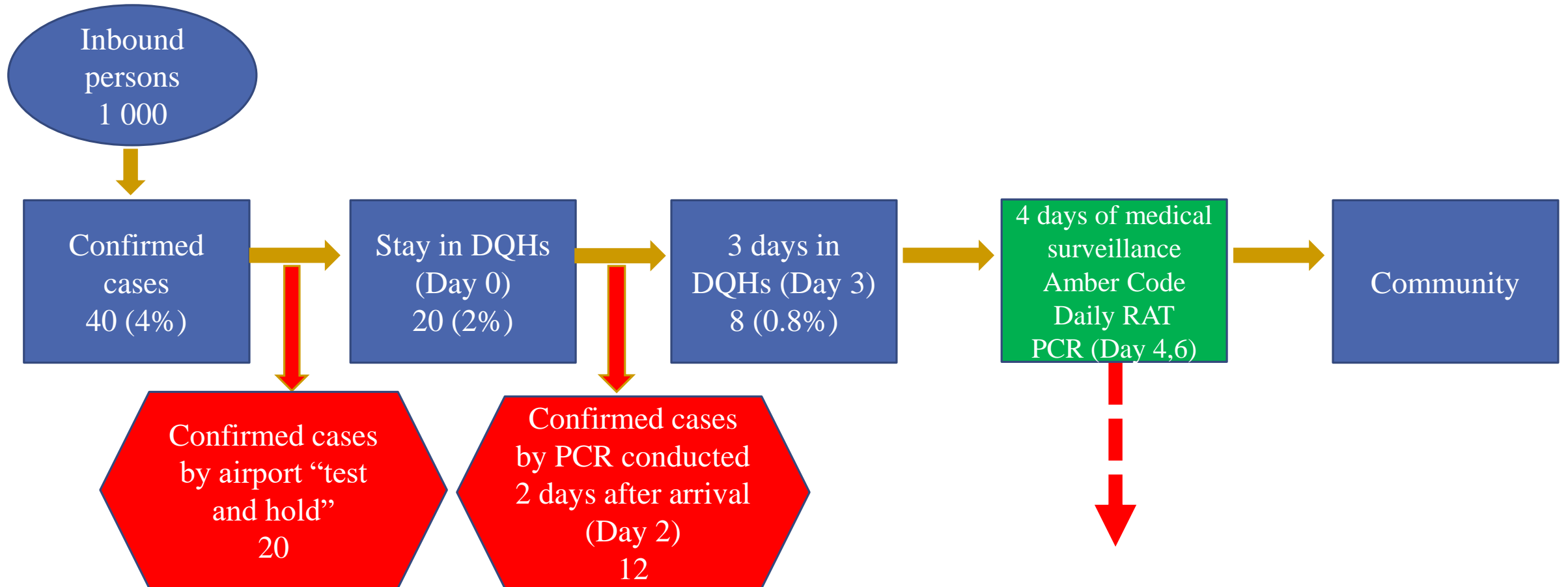

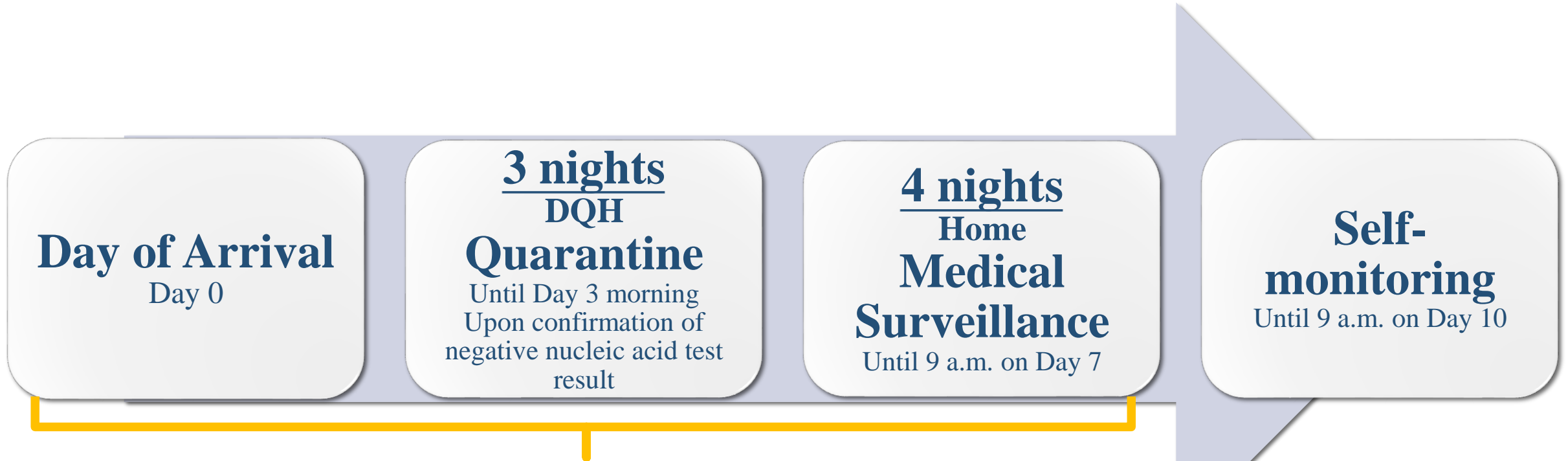

## Adjusted quarantine arrangements

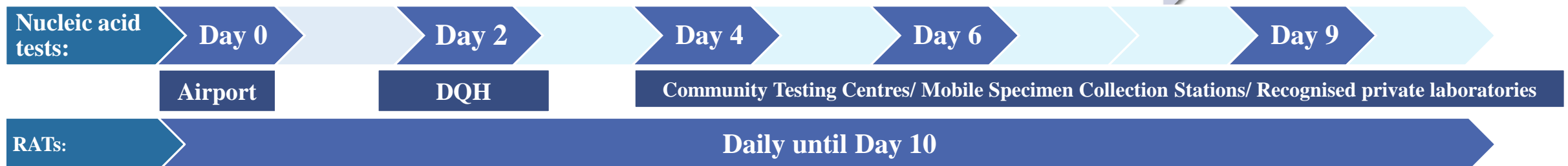
