

## **Arrival Quarantine and Testing Procedures**

The quarantine and testing procedures of inbound persons at the airport are detailed as follows –

- All inbound persons complete a one-stop registration upon arrival at the specimen collection stations on the arrival level of Terminal 1, and undergo specimen collection for nucleic acid test and rapid antigen test (RAT) on the spot.
- Person holding a green health declaration QR code can proceed with immigration procedures and baggage collection after completion of specimen collection. If his or her RAT negative result is confirmed by the time he or she leaves the baggage reclaim hall, he or she can continue to take point-to-point transport under closed-loop arrangement to DQHs and wait for the result of nucleic acid tests and undergo quarantine there.
- Person holding a pink health declaration QR code is required to proceed to the Midfield Concourse of the airport upon completion of specimen collection to further confirm relevant documents and information before he or she can proceed with immigration procedures.

In addition to the above additional boarding requirement, relevant inbound persons will continue to be required to provide proof of pre-departure tests (only applicable to inbound persons aged 3 or above), i.e. (i) negative result proof of a PCR-based nucleic acid test within 48 hours of the scheduled time of departure; or (ii) documentary proof to show that they were infected with the virus 14 to 90 days prior to boarding for Hong Kong, together with negative result proof of a RAT conducted within 24 hours of the scheduled time of departure.
