**\*Remarks:**

Upon liaison, some private hospitals have allocated more beds for receiving patients from the Hospital Authority, including CUHK Medical Centre which has increased the number from 36 to 42 with effect from August 29, and St. Teresa's Hospital from 50 to 60 with effect from August 30. Furthermore, St. Paul's Hospital has been gradually increasing the number of beds from 25 to 35 in order to receive more cases.
