Hong Kong Adventist Hospital – Tsuen Wan deployed more beds since September 1 with the number of beds increased from 30 to 40, while St. Paul's Hospital also made an increase on the same day by expanding from 25 beds to 35 beds. Furthermore, St. Teresa's Hospital has further increased the number of beds to receive more cases with effect from September 6, with the number of beds having grown from 60 to at least 70.

On the other hand, CUHK Medical Centre plans to add eight more beds for COVID-19 patients next week. The relevant figure has yet to be reflected in the above table.
