Food and Environmental Hygiene Department	Stepped up the cleansing/clearance and pest control work for hygiene black spots	3 513 special cleansing/clearance and pest control operations against 165 black spots
Highways Department	Cleansing of footbridges, subways and retaining walls and clearance of construction wastes and graffiti at hygiene blackspots	141 special cleansing operations against 48 black spots
Home Affairs Department	Coordinated joint operations with relevant departments /arranged enhanced cleansing of hygiene black spots by District Offices	Conducted special cleansing operations against 228 black spots ¹
Housing Department	Conducted special cleansing operations at hygiene black spots in Public Rental Housing estates	Around 1 030 special cleansing operations against 24 black spots
Marine Department	Joint special cleansing operation was conducted at the Aberdeen Typhoon Shelters

Home Affairs Department	(a) Coordinated joint operations with relevant departments for removal of abandoned vehicles at public back alleys	45 locations
