For eligible social security recipients, the amount of the one-off extra allowance equals to one half of the monthly standard rate of Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) payments, Old Age Allowance (OAA), Old Age Living Allowance (OALA) or Disability Allowance (DA). Examples of the amounts are as follows:

As regards the Working Family Allowance (WFA), the one-off extra allowance equals to one half of the average monthly allowance in approved months in the corresponding household's most recent WFA application, which was submitted from November 1, 2022 to May 3, 2023 and eventually approved. The amount varies from case to case.
