

Details of Redistribution of Civil Servants Priority Discs

Date	Details
From 1 September 2015	<p>Redistribute four priority discs from Kwun Tong Community Health Centre to Lam Tin Polyclinic GOPC, representing a 20% increase in the number of priority discs in the latter.</p> <p>Redistribute five priority discs from Sha Tin (Tai Wai) GOPC to Fanling Family Medicine Centre, representing an around 15% increase in the number of priority discs in the latter.</p>
From 1 April 2019	<p>Redistribute 11 priority discs from Kwun Tong Community Health Centre and six priority discs from Mona Fong GOPC to Kowloon Bay Health Centre GOPC (an increase of nine discs) and Tseung Kwan O (Po Ning Road) GOPC (an increase of eight discs), representing a 75% and 30% increase in the number of priority discs in Kowloon Bay Health Centre GOPC and Tseung Kwan O (Po Ning Road) GOPC respectively.</p> <p>Redistribute eight priority discs from Yuen Long Jockey Club Health Centre to Tin Shui Wai (Tin Yip Road) Community Health Centre, representing a 100% increase in the number of priority discs in the latter.</p>
From 1 April 2020	<p>Redistribute five priority discs from Sai Ying Pun Jockey Club GOPC to Aberdeen Jockey Club GOPC, representing a 20% increase in the number of priority discs in the latter.</p> <p>Redistribute ten priority discs from Robert Black GOPC to East Kowloon GOPC, representing a 40% increase in the number of priority discs in the latter.</p> <p>Redistribute ten priority discs from Central Kowloon Health Centre to Shun Tak Fraternal Association Leung Kau Kui Clinic, representing a 67% increase in the number of priority discs in the latter.</p>

Date	Details
From 1 April 2021	<p>Redistribute ten priority discs from Chai Wan GOPC and 25 priority discs from Violet Peel GOPC to Anne Black GOPC (an increase of 15 discs) and Sai Wan Ho GOPC (an increase of 20 discs), representing a 60% and 100% increase in the number of priority discs in Anne Black GOPC and in Sai Wan Ho GOPC respectively.</p> <p>Redistribute six priority discs from Yan Oi GOPC to Tuen Mun Wu Hong Clinic, representing a 20% increase in the number of priority discs in the latter.</p>
