

Commemorative Stamp Issue – “The 10th Anniversary of the Belt and Road Initiative”
(7 September 2023)

This \$10 Stamp Sheetlet is designed by Mr Gideon LAI and printed in lithography by Henan Posts and Telecommunications Company Limited, the People’s Republic of China.

Official first day covers will be put on sale at **\$2.5 each at all post offices** from **24 August 2023**. Display of the stamp sheetlet and associated philatelic products will be put up at General Post Office (GPO), Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office on 31 August 2023 for public’s view. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 24 to 30 August 2023.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service with the office date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 7 September 2023 at all post offices for official first day covers/souvenir covers/privately made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and its respective philatelic office pictorial postmark. The GPO-1 date-stamp impression will only be available at the GPO.

Collection points will be set up at all post offices on 7 September 2023 for submission of official first day covers/souvenir covers/privately made covers requesting hand-back date-stamping service.
