

Special Stamp Issue – “Hong Kong Vegetables”
(21 September 2023)

This set of special stamps is designed by Mr Benny LAU and printed in lithography by Joh. Enschedé Stamps B.V., the Netherlands.

Official first day covers will be put on sale at **\$2.5 each at all post offices** from **7 September 2023**. Display of the special stamps and associated philatelic products will be put up at General Post Office (GPO), Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office from 14 September 2023 for public’s view. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 7 September 2023 to 13 September 2023.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service with the office date-stamp and the special postmarks will be provided on 21 September 2023 at all post offices for official first day covers/souvenir covers/private made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and its respective philatelic office pictorial postmark. The GPO-1 date-stamp impression will only be available at the GPO.
