The crime statistics of NEC persons on recognisance and issued with Form No. 8 (January to October 2023)

According to the Police's information, from January to October 2023, a total of 604 NEC persons on recognisance and issued with Form No. 8 (mainly non-refoulement claimants) were arrested for criminal offences. The breakdowns of the number of persons arrested by the crime category are tabulated below:

Note 1: "Serious drug offences" include possession of dangerous drugs exceeding a specified amount (i.e. possession of drugs, such as 5 grams of cocaine/heroin/marijuana, etc.), manufacturing dangerous drugs, trafficking of dangerous drugs, etc.

Note 2: "Serious immigration offences" include aiding and abetting illegal immigrants, arranging passage of unauthorized entrants to Hong Kong and using an identity card relating to another person, etc.

Note 3: "Others" include criminal intimidation, indecent assault, child abuse and possession of offensive weapon, etc.

Note 4: "Triad-related" arrested persons involve in offences including serious drug offences, criminal damage and serious gambling offences, etc.
