Grand Bauhinia Medal (GBM)

The Honourable LIAO Cheung-kong, Martin, GBS, JP

Hon LIAO is a Member of the Executive Council and the Legislative Council (LegCo), and has served as the convenor of the LegCo since 2022. Professor LAU Siu-kai, GBS, JP
