The Working Group for Enhancing Personalised Point-to-Point Transport Services under the Transport Advisory Committee

The Transport Advisory Committee (TAC) established the Working Group for Enhancing Personalised Point-to-Point Transport Services in July 2024 for a term of office of two years. The terms of reference are as follows:

- (1) to explore the strategic direction for enhancing personalised point-topoint transport services to allow taxis (including fleet taxis and nonfleet taxis) as well as licensed and compliant vehicles to complement each other's strengths in the provision of the services concerned, with a view to coping with the public's demand for the services concerned, and facilitating the healthy and sustainable development of the services concerned in the long run;
- (2) to explore ways to regulate online car hailing platforms;
- (3) to advise on the Transport Department's study on the demand and supply of personalised point-to-point transport services, including the passenger demand and changes, as well as the assessment of the types and number of vehicles which may provide compliant services through online car hailing platforms in the future;
- (4) subject to the findings of the above three studies, to explore the applicable regulatory arrangements, including ways to enhance the existing regulatory arrangements for hire car permits; and
- (5) to submit report to TAC in due course, and report to the Government after discussion and agreement by TAC.
