


行政長官2024年施政報告 The Chief Executive's 2024 Policy Address



Policy direction

- Be result-oriented
- Focus on economic growth and on improving people's livelihood through
 development, with the well-being of the people of Hong Kong close to our hearts
- Reform is a **continuous process**. We strive to keep up our momentum for advancement and **self-renewal**
- Our proposals must take heed of the prevailing circumstances and be tailored to local conditions



The reform process and considerations

Process

- Establish essential structures that are lacking in the system
- Rectify serious shortcomings
- Overcome bottlenecks, weaknesses or hurdles
- Reinforce and improve areas in need of consolidation

Considerations

- See the present from a historical perspective and look beyond the surface to get to the crux of issues
- Systemic mindset
 - Relationship between **overall** and **local** interests
 - Relationship between the present and the future
 - Relationship between **primary** and **secondary conflicts**
 - Relationship between the special and the ordinary
 - Relationship between **macro** and **micro** concerns
 - Macro concerns a global perspective of the world trend, the strategic outlook of our nation and the societal interests
 - Micro concerns daily needs of our **people**

Transformation of the Policy Address' goals

Gradual progression: different times, different goals, different themes

The year 2022 was a time when Hong Kong was **troubled by the pandemic**. Our policy goal was "**Join hands in the same boat. Ride out the storm together**". The theme of the Policy Address was "Charting a **Brighter Tomorrow** for Hong Kong".

The year 2023 was a time when Hong Kong finally **emerged from the pandemic**. It was a time when Hong Kong embarked on its course of advancing from stability to prosperity. Our policy goal was "**Bring people's smiles back as society resumes to normality. Create jobs as we revitalise the economy**". The theme of the Policy Address was "A **Vibrant Economy** for a **Caring Community**".

The year 2024 is a time when **security** is assured and when we could devote our full efforts to **the advancement from stability to prosperity**. Our policy goal is "**Reform for change. Set every sail. Unleash all strengths**". The theme of the Policy Address is "**Reform** for Enhancing **Development** and Building Our **Future** Together".

2024 Policy Address - Summary

The focus of the 2024 Policy Address is to reform and embrace changes, with a view to exploring new growth areas. Measures include:

- 1) Consolidate and enhance our status as an international financial, shipping and trade centre. The development of finance, shipping and trade are closely intertwined and could complement each other to promote integrated development. Measures include: developing world-class gold storage facilities, building an international gold trading market, creating a commodity trading ecosystem, establishing internationally recognised warehouses for non-ferrous metal products, developing Hong Kong into a green maritime centre, and so on.
- 2) Develop new quality productive forces tailored to local conditions. Measures include: developing the low-altitude economy; setting up a \$10 billion I&T Industry-Oriented Fund to invest in emerging and future industries of strategic importance, promote the development of new energy, developing Hong Kong into an international health and medical innovation hub, joining hands with Shenzhen to establish the GBA Clinical Trial Collaboration Platform to give full play to Hong Kong's clinical trial capability, and so on.

2024 Policy Address - Summary

- 3) Build Hong Kong into an International hub for high-calibre talents. Measures include: setting up the Committee on Education, Technology and Talents to co-ordinate the integrated development of education, technology and talents; developing the Northern Metropolis University Town; and so on.
- 4) Promote integrated development of culture, sports and tourism and foster economic diversification. Measures include: developing Kai Tak Sports Park into a sports and mega event landmark, enhancing cultural confidence, revitalising Hong Kong's tourism industry, and so on.
- 5) Take forward the development of the Northern Metropolis as a growth engine and deepen GBA collaboration. Measures include: taking forward the development of the Northern Metropolis, envisaging the new look of the Northern Metropolis in five years and ten years' time after the completion of projects, promoting the development of the Hong Kong-Shenzhen I&T Park in the Loop and publishing the Development Outline for the Hong Kong Park of the Hetao Shenzhen-Hong Kong Science and Technology Innovation Co-operation Zone, and so on.

2024 Policy Address – Summary

- 6) **Improve people's livelihood**. Measures include:
 - Tackling the issue of subdivided units in an orderly manner by devising a system on the renting of subdivided units in residential buildings: **Basic Housing Units**; **relaxing** the maximum **loan-to-value ratio** for all properties to **70**%
 - Reforming the Employees Retraining Board by removing the cap on education level from the eligibility criteria for service recipients targeting at the entire workforce aged 15 or above, and carrying out a comprehensive reform through short-, medium- to long-term measures; implementing the annual review mechanism of the Statutory Minimum Wage; amending the continuous contract requirement by relaxing the threshold from working 18 hours in a week for four consecutive weeks (i.e. 72 hours in total) to an aggregate of 68 hours in four weeks, making it easier for employees to enjoy comprehensive employment rights
 - Deepening **reform** of the **healthcare** system by reforming the functions and division of work among the **Hospital Authority**, the **Department of Health** and the **Primary Healthcare Commission**; extending the "1+" **mechanism** to all new drugs to facilitate the **usage of good drugs in Hong Kong**; publishing the **Chinese Medicine Development Blueprint**; supporting the establishment of a **third medical school**
 - Revamping maternal and child health and family-planning services to strengthen pre-pregnancy counselling and promote healthy fertility; setting up an additional child care centre; increasing the number of primary schools covered by the School-based After-School Care Service Scheme to over 110
 - Increasing the number of **Community Living Rooms** from four to seven; launching a **community pharmacy programme** and develop a **community drug formulary** to help the public obtain affordable, primary-healthcare drugs
 - Eight measures supporting small and medium enterprises, developing the silver economy, and so on
