Note 1: Labour force refers to the land-based non-institutional population aged 15 and over (excluding foreign domestic helpers) who satisfy the criteria for being classified as employed persons or unemployed persons. Inmates of institutions and persons living on board vessels are excluded. The number of persons are rounded to the nearest hundred.

Note 2: Number of employed persons includes working proprietors/partners/directors, unpaid family workers and employees of establishments who have worked for at least one hour on the survey reference date, as well as manual workers who have worked at construction sites on the survey reference date. Civil servants are excluded from the figures. Figures of the number of employed persons are as at June of the year.

Note 3: Figures in the table may not add up to the total due to rounding.
