Notes:

1. Due to the time required for processing applications, data lag, etc., there is a deviation between the “Number of applications” and the “Number of accredited Star Enterprises”.
2. The “Cumulative number of accredited Star Enterprises” refers to the number of Star Enterprises after deducting those have not renewed/are applying for renewal in that year. (Note: The validity period of an accredited Star Enterprise is two years.)
3. OSHC consultants will take the initiative to contact the enterprises applying for the Scheme and assist them in establishing their safety management systems. However, some of the applicants have not been able to become Star Enterprises (including those which have failed to renew their applications) because they have failed to participate in setting up the relevant systems or complete the designated safety training courses as

required due to various reasons. For this reason, the applications of these enterprises are classified as “Assessment in Progress” and they may apply for further assessment whenever necessary. Therefore, they are not regarded as “Enterprises failed to be accredited under the Accreditation Scheme”.
