For eligible social security recipients, the amount of the one-off extra allowance is equal to one half of the monthly standard rate of Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) payments, Old Age Allowance (OAA), Old Age Living Allowance (OALA) or Disability Allowance (DA). Examples of payment levels are as follows:

As regards the Working Family Allowance (WFA), the one-off extra allowance is equal to one half of the average monthly allowance in approved months in the corresponding households' most recent WFA applications which were submitted within the period from October 1, 2024 to April 30, 2025 and approved. The amount varies from case to case.
