Mr MAN volunteered to take rescue action, and even inhaled hot dense smoke during the rescue, displaying an extraordinary level of gallantry and selflessness.

Ms HO Yuen-tung

Ms HO, an Air Crewman Officer III, is awarded MBB in recognition of her great courage, selflessness and professionalism. During the onslaught of Severe Typhoon Yinxing on 8 November 2024, Ms HO was deployed by the Government Flying Service as a winchman to reach the distressed barge located approximately 320 kilometers southeast of Hong Kong from the rescue helicopter, despite severe rocking and swaying due to the tumultuous sea with limited visibility. She chose to remain in the hostile environment, successfully recovering seven seamen using the safest and most efficient means. She systematically and professionally prioritised the safety of the seamen above her own in an extremely dangerous environment. She fearlessly committed to duty and displayed an extraordinary level of gallantry and determination.

Mr CHAU Ji-yu, Kenneth

Mr CHAU is awarded MBB in recognition of his noble act of great courage. On 10 April 2024, a huge fire broke out at New Lucky House in Jordan claiming the lives of five individuals and injuring 40 others. As he passed by the fire scene, Mr CHAU conducted the rescue operations in collaboration with some nearby construction workers after risk assessment which he has learnt from the Civil Aid Service. By applying his well-trained emergency rescue knowledge of ladder operation and evacuation techniques, he saved over ten people who were desperately in need of help. After the rescue operations, he also assisted to apply water hose to control the fire from spreading. Mr CHAU responded rapidly, displaying an extraordinary level of gallantry and selflessness.
