Note 1: As every application involved safety training, consultancy services, safety audits, and assisting SMEs in establishing safety management systems, which takes a rather long time for processing and may span across years. Cumulative figures are thus used to show the progress of application approval for the Accreditation Scheme.

Note 2: The applications approved included certified “Star Enterprises” and enterprises undergoing certification

Note 3: The applications under review included enterprises that had not provided all documents for the application or had not completed the safety training courses.
