Note 1: Some kaito ferry routes have been covered by the Government Public Transport Fare Concession Scheme for the Elderly and Eligible Persons with Disabilities (the \$2 Scheme) since February 27, 2022, and started submitting operational data to the Transport Department (TD). Therefore, the patronage data of the above routes in 2022 covers only the period from February 27 to December 31, 2022.

Note 2: Since the “Tai Shui Hang – Lai Chi Wo/Kat O/Ap Chau” route (TP 19) has been covered by the \$2 Scheme since December 8, 2022, and started submitting operational data to the TD, only its patronage from that day onwards is covered in the above table.

Note 3: As the “Sai Kung – Fo Tau Fan Chau (The Dawn Island Pier)” route (SK 154) is not covered by the \$2 Scheme and not required to submit operational data to the TD, the TD does not maintain the patronage of the route.
