

Commemorative Stamp Issue – “80th Anniversary of the Victory in the Chinese People’s War of Resistance against Japanese Aggression and the World Anti-Fascist War”
(3 September 2025)

The stamp sheetlet is designed by Mr Bon KWAN and printed in lithography by Beijing Stamp Printing House Company Limited.

Official first day covers will be put on sale at **\$2.5 each at all post offices** from **27 August 2025**. Display of the stamp sheetlet and associated philatelic products will be put up at General Post Office (GPO), Kowloon Bay Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office, Tuen Mun Central Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office and Tsuen Wan Post Office from 27 August 2025 for public’s view. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 27 August to 2 September 2025.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service with the office date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 3 September 2025 at all post offices for official first day covers/souvenir covers/privately made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and its respective philatelic office pictorial postmark. The GPO-1 date-stamp impression will only be available at the GPO.

Special Arrangements

To tie in with the above sales arrangements, Chuk Yuen Post Office will be opened from 9:30am to 4:30pm on 3 September 2025.
