Children and adolescents aged 6 months to under 18 years	<p>General children: School outreach vaccination programme/ Family doctors</p> <p>Children with chronic illness: Public or private clinics providing regular follow-up appointments</p> <p>Children aged 6 months to 2 years: Family doctors/ Maternal and Child Health Centres</p>
Pregnant women	Family doctors/ Public or private antenatal clinics
Residents of residential care homes	Residential care homes concerned
Health care workers	Public or private clinics/ Family doctors/ DHCs
Poultry workers, pig farmers and pig-slaughtering industry personnel	DHCs/ Designated public clinics
