- The figures only include service figures captured from the District Health Centre and District Health Centre Express information system, and do not include those relating to medical laboratory tests.
- Chronic Disease Co-care Pilot Scheme and women's health services were launched on 13 November 2023 and 24 January 2025 respectively.
- As different services are provided by the District Health Centre Expresses, the attendance figures are not directly comparable.
- Category 1 services includes health promotion/education.
- Category 2 services includes health risk factor assessment, screening for diabetes mellitus and hypertension, chronic disease management, community rehabilitation and women's health services.
- Central and Western DHCE has upgraded to DHC on 10 September 2025. Yau Tsim Mong DHCE has upgraded to DHC on 27 October 2025.
- Eastern DHCE was upgraded to DHC on 15 December 2025. It is thus listed as a District Health Centre Express in Annex III, which shows data as at 30 November 2025.
