Provision of Heated Pool at the Pao Yue Kong Swimming Pool Complex in the Southern District	The 2020 Policy Address announced the “Invigorating Island South” initiative which included the “Redevelopment and Enhancement of Recreation and Sports Facilities in Wong Chuk Hang” project. The proposed joint recreation and sports complex in the project will feature new indoor heated swimming pools, which will achieve the purpose of the project of “Provision of Heated Pool at the Pao Yue Kong Swimming Pool Complex in the Southern District”.

23. Sports Ground and Open Space with Public Vehicle Park in Area 16, Tuen Mun	<p>This project site is currently used for several temporary purposes, including bus depots of two bus companies (Tuen Mun depots) and a fee-paying public vehicle park.</p> <p>The two bus companies have identified sites for relocation, and short-term tenancies for the new sites have been granted by the Lands Department for re-provisioning their bus depots in Area 16, Tuen Mun at the new sites. It is expected that they will vacate and return the site in Area 16, Tuen Mun in the second quarter of 2026 and in 2027 respectively.</p> <p>The Government will continue to carry out other preparatory work so that the works project can commence immediately after the tender exercise is completed and funding approval is obtained from the Finance Committee of the Legislative Council.</p>
24. Football-cum-Rugby Pitch with Public Vehicle Park in Area 33, Tai Po	According to the Government's policy of "single site, multiple use", these three projects will provide public vehicle parks in addition to the originally planned sports and recreation facilities, with a view to
