For eligible social security recipients, the amount of the one-off extra allowance is equal to one month of the standard rate of the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA), Old Age Allowance (OAA), Old Age Living Allowance (OALA) or Disability Allowance (DA). Examples of payment levels are as follows:

Note 1: The amount of the extra allowance payable to each recipient is rounded to the nearest integer. The amount of extra allowance for a household case equals the sum of the extra allowance payable to each household member.

Note 2: Including the allowances under the Guangdong Scheme and the Fujian Scheme.

As regards the Working Family Allowance (WFA), the one-off extra allowance will equal the average monthly allowance of the approved months in a recipient's most recently submitted WFA application, which was submitted within the period from October 1, 2025 to April 29, 2026 and eventually approved. The amount varies from case to case.
