**Hon Ken WONG's motion on  
“Promoting digital education in Hong Kong's primary and secondary  
schools to cultivate future digital talents”**

**Wording of the Motion**

That given the rapid development of artificial intelligence (‘AI’) and big data technologies, digital education has become the core of global education reform; the Outline of the National 15th Five-Year Plan stipulates promoting the transformation of education models through AI; in order to support the SAR Government in formulating Hong Kong's first five-year plan, and to enhance Hong Kong's education competitiveness and cultivate future digital talents, this Council urges the SAR Government, when formulating Hong Kong's five-year plan, to develop a comprehensive digital education strategy and establish clear development visions and phased targets to expedite the implementation of digital education in primary and secondary schools; to strengthen professional support for teachers to help them master the ability to employ AI-assisted teaching, thereby enhancing learning and teaching effectiveness; and to comprehensively review the primary and secondary school curricula and assessment mechanisms, with a view to strengthening students' digital literacy and computational thinking, thereby laying a solid foundation for their further studies and employment.
