**Prof Hon Priscilla LEUNG's motion on
“Charting Hong Kong's first five-year plan and
deepening the development of Hong Kong as an international legal hub”**

Wording of the Motion

That this Council urges the SAR Government to seize the new opportunities brought about by the Outline of the National 15th Five-Year Plan and, in Hong Kong's first five-year plan to be published, to fully leverage the advantages of Hong Kong's common law system, bilingual legal talents and international legal services in order to deepen the development of Hong Kong as an international legal hub; to strengthen the training of legal talents in international law, maritime law, foreign-related rule of law, arbitration and international mediation, etc., in conjunction with the establishment of the headquarters of the International Organization for Mediation in Hong Kong and the planned construction of the Hong Kong International Legal Service Building; and to promote the enactment of legislation and rules on emerging fields such as artificial intelligence, digital assets, cross-boundary data flow, the low-altitude economy and the space economy, so as to assist the country in expanding its international discourse power in these fields and step up efforts to tell the good stories of ‘one country, two systems’ and the Basic Law to the international community.
