The Honourable CHAN Kin-por, GBS, JP

Hon CHAN is a Non-official Member of the Executive Council. Medal for Bravery (Gold) (MBG)

Mr HO Wai-ho (posthumous)

The late Mr HO, Senior Fireman (Posthumous), is posthumously awarded MBG in recognition of his act of the most conspicuous courage, selflessness and bravery of the highest order. On 26 November 2025, Mr HO responded to a firefighting and rescue operation in a No. 5 alarm fire at Wang Fuk Court in Tai Po as a member of the first batch of rescue teams. In the course of performing his duty, Mr HO encountered extreme heat and fierce blaze. Notwithstanding the grave danger to his own life, he continued his rescue work and risked his life to save others. Amidst the intense battle against the fire, he was stranded in danger and found unconscious when located later. He was conveyed to the hospital immediately but unfortunately was certified dead on the same day. Mr HO displayed unwavering dedication, utmost bravery and selfless devotion to the public in carrying out the rescue operation. He demonstrated gallantry of the highest order.

Silver Bauhinia Star (SBS)
